Nina will comment on how people think and behave when they are in dispute and identify the most important issues affecting people's behaviour. She will also analyse how our values and beliefs affect our view of the world and how people make decisions so as to help parties make better lasting decisions in mediation. There will be lots of practical and pragmatic tips and ideas for dealing with multifarious types of disputes that will fascinate any mediator. Fault, hind.
